



Day Camp Packing List

Please label **EVERYTHING** with at least first and last initials

A bunk and a storage area will be assigned to your day camper in a cabin to be used for the week. Items may be stored there and collected on the last day. If your camper uses any of their extra clothing, please remember to replace these items.

Packing List

- ☐ Shower towel (1 or 2)
- ☐ Swim Suit (1 or 2)
- ☐ Beach/Pool towel (1 or 2)
- ☐ Rain gear (raincoat, and rain boots)
- ☐ Water bottle with your name on it (1 or 2)
- ☐ Sunscreen and bug repellent
- ☐ Any medications or supplements (collected by nurse)
- ☐ Laundry bag (pillowcases work great!)
- ☐ Flashlight and/or headlamp with extra batteries

- ☐ Bedding:
 - ☐ Pillow with pillowcase
 - ☐ Twin-size fitted sheet
 - ☐ Sleeping bag or 2+ blankets

**please check the weather to plan ahead for unusually cold nights*

- ☐ Clothing:
 - ☐ Daily changes of underwear and socks
 - ☐ Wear comfortable shirts/tank tops (2 extra)
 - ☐ Wear comfortable bottoms (1 or 2 extra)
 - ☐ At least 1 long-sleeve shirt
 - ☐ Pajamas (for Thursday traditions and possible overnight)
 - ☐ Warm sweatshirt or a light jacket

**check the weather and plan accordingly*

- ☐ Sturdy, comfortable, close-toed shoes for hiking and for active wear (1-2 pairs)
- ☐ Waterproof shoes for pool (Crocs, sandals)
- ☐ Toiletries
 - ☐ Toothbrush and toothpaste
 - ☐ Brush/comb and hair ties
 - ☐ Shampoo/Conditioner
 - ☐ Body wash/Bar soap with case
 - ☐ Menstrual products
 - ☐ Other toiletries (**reminder no fragrance or perfumes)

Optional/Suggested Items:

- ☐ Sunglasses or hat
- ☐ Stuffed animal/comfort item
- ☐ Clean, white item(s) (socks, T-shirt, bandana, etc) to use for Tie-Dye
- ☐ A book, journal, and/or other quiet games to be enjoyed by yourself or shared with your friends during rest hour/cabin time
- ☐ Non-electric musical instruments (guitar, ukulele, flute, etc)
- ☐ Stamps, cards, and envelopes to write letters
- ☐ A bag to carry everyday items (drawstring, tote, small backpack)

Do not bring:

- ☐ Any food, especially candy and gum (unless guardians have made arrangements with camp leadership)
- ☐ Phones & other electronics
- ☐ Make up, mirrors, perfume/ body spray
- ☐ Sharp items (shaving razors, knives, tools)
- ☐ Firearms, fireworks, and other explosives
- ☐ Cigarettes, e-cigarettes, marijuana in any form, or alcohol

***Space is limited, bring only what is needed. Keep valuables at home. Camp is not responsible for lost or damaged belongings. ***
