



Overnight/Try-Me Camp Packing List

Please label EVERYTHING with at least first and last initials

A bunk and a storage area will be assigned to your camper in a cabin to be used for the week. Items may be stored there and collected on the last day. If staying for Sessions 4, 5, and 6, laundry will be collected, washed with sensitive skin/fragrance-free/dye-free detergent, and dried without dryer sheets during the bridge weekend.

- Beach towel (1 or 2)
- Swim Suit (1 or 2)
- Rain gear
- Pillow with pillowcase
- Sleeping bag or 2-3 blankets
- 1 twin fitted sheet
- Sturdy, comfortable shoes for hiking/running (2 or 3 pairs) (please leave flip-flops at home; Keen or Teva-type sandals are great; Crocs to and from the pool are okay)
- Daily changes of underwear and socks (plus 1 or 2 extra)
- Comfortable shirts/tank tops (1 per camp day, plus 1 or 2 extra)
- Comfortable pants/shorts (1 per camp day, plus 1 or 2 extra)
- Pajamas (2 or 3 pairs)
- Warm sweater/sweatshirt/light jacket (2 or 3)
- Backpack/Zipper bag for small items
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Shampoo/Conditioner or 2-in-1
- Deodorant

- Hairbrush and/or comb
- Hairties/Scrunchies/Headbands
- Body wash/Bar soap with case
- Water bottle
- YOUR HEALTH AND IMMUNIZATION FORMS, completed and signed (if not mailed in, emailed, or uploaded to our registration site)
- Any prescription medications (collected by medical personnel at registration)
- Glasses/Contacts with case and solution (if needed)
- Sunscreen and bug repellent (preferably not in aerosol cans)
- Laundry bag (pillowcases work great!)

Optional Items:

- Sunglasses
- Wristwatch (not a smartwatch, please)
- 1 twin flat sheet (especially if not using a sleeping bag)
- Clean, white item (socks, T-shirt, bandana, etc) to use for Tie-Dye
- A book, journal, or other quiet items to be enjoyed during rest hour (we do have a library with books and games here at camp)
- Non-electric musical instruments (guitar, ukulele, trumpet, etc)
- Stamps, cards, and envelopes to write letters
- A stuffed animal/comfort item

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

- ALL food, especially candy and gum
- Phones, iPads, and other electronics
- Make-up, mirrors, and perfume/body spray
- Firearms and fireworks
- Knives, razors, and other sharps (we use safety scissors at camp)
- Money (the camp store will be open only on the first and last days of each session)

If any of these items are brought to camp, the items will be sent back with the parent/guardian present at registration, or the items will be stored and locked in a secure area. They are not allowed in the cabins due to safety concerns and to maintain the natural environment of the camp. Camp is not responsible for lost or damaged belongings.

Please try to bring the minimum amount and label EVERYTHING with at least first and last initials.
